DOES YOUR GROUP HAVE A “LINK” WITH A.A. AS A WHOLE?

GENERAL SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE (GSR)

“The general service representative (GSR) has the job of linking his or her group with A.A. as a whole. The G.S.R. represents the voice of the group conscience, reporting the group’s thoughts to the district committee member and to the delegate, who passes them on to the Conference. This communication is a two-way street, making the G.S.R. responsible for bringing back to the group Conference Actions that affect A.A. unity, health, and growth. Only when a G.S.R. keeps the group informed, and communicates the group conscience, can the Conference truly act for A.A. as a whole.”

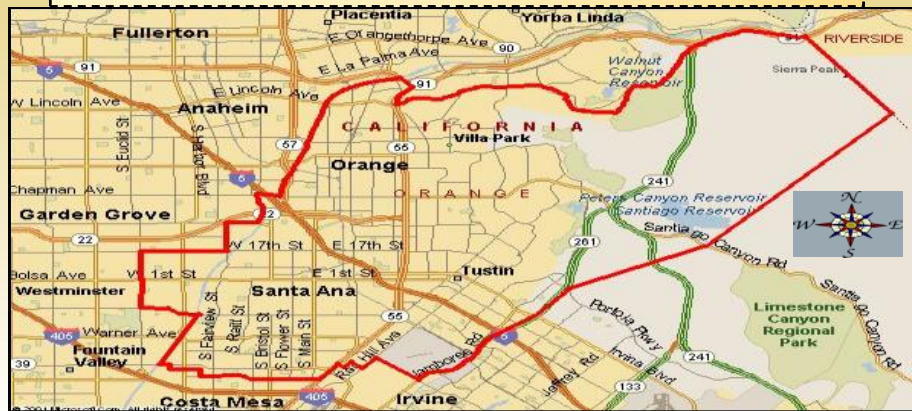

STEPS: 4, 5, & 6

"Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves."

[5]

"Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs."

[6]

"Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character."

STEP 4 (Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions Book - pp. 42-43):

"...Step Four is our vigorous and painstaking effort to discover what these liabilities in each of us have been, and are.

We want to find exactly how, when and where our natural desires have warped us. We wish to look squarely at the unhappiness this has caused others and ourselves. By discovering what our emotional deformities are, we can move toward their correction. Without a willing and persistent effort to do this, there can be little sobriety or contentment for us. Without a searching and fearless moral inventory, most of us have found that the faith which really works in daily living is still out of reach."

TRADITIONS: 4, 5, & 6

Short Form:

"Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or A.A. as a whole."

[5]

Short Form:

"Each group has but one primary purpose — to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers."

[6]

Short Form:

"An A.A. group ought never endorse, finance, or lend the A.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property, and prestige divert us from our primary purpose."

Tradition 4 (Long Form / P-16 The A.A. Group...Where It All Begins - Pg. 43):

"With respect to its own affairs, each A.A. group should be responsible to no other authority than its own conscience. But when its plans concern the welfare of neighboring groups also, those groups ought to be consulted. And no group, regional committee, or individual should ever take any action that might greatly affect A.A. as a whole without conferring with the trustees of the General Service Board. On such issues our common welfare is paramount."

Short Form:

"At all responsible levels, we ought to maintain a traditional "Right of Participation," allowing a voting representation in reasonable proportion to the responsibility that each must discharge."

Short Form:

"Throughout our structure, a traditional "Right of Appeal" ought to prevail, so that minority opinion will be heard and personal grievances receive careful consideration."

[6]

Short Form:

"The Charter and Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments, empowering the trustees to manage and conduct world service affairs. The Conference Charter is not a legal document; it relies upon tradition and the A.A. purse for final effectiveness."

CONCEPTS 4 (Long Form / P-16 The A.A. Group...Where It All Begins - Pg. 47):

"Throughout our Conference structure, we ought to maintain at all responsible levels a traditional "Right of Participation", taking care that each classification or group of our world servants shall be allowed a voting representation in reasonable proportion to the responsibility that each must discharge."

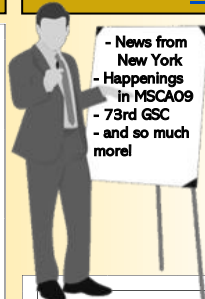

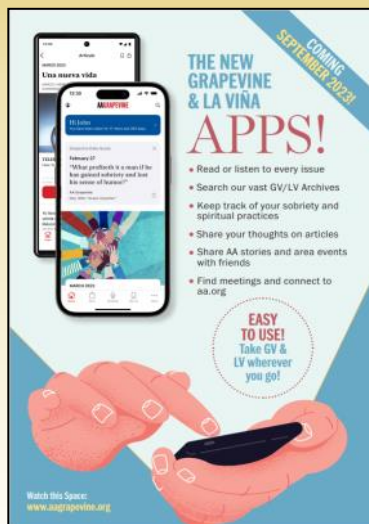

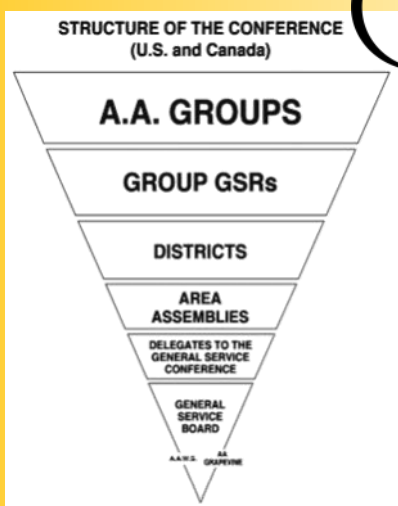
