DOES YOUR GROUP HAVE A “LINK” WITH A.A. AS A WHOLE?

GENERAL SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE (GSR)

“The general service representative (GSR) has the job of linking his or her group with A.A. as a whole. The G.S.R. represents the voice of the group conscience, reporting the group’s thoughts to the district committee member and to the delegate, who passes them on to the Conference. This communication is a two-way street, making the G.S.R. responsible for bringing back to the group Conference Actions that affect A.A. unity, health, and growth. Only when a G.S.R. keeps the group informed, and communicates the group conscience, can the Conference truly act for A.A. as a whole.” (Copied from MSCA09’s website)

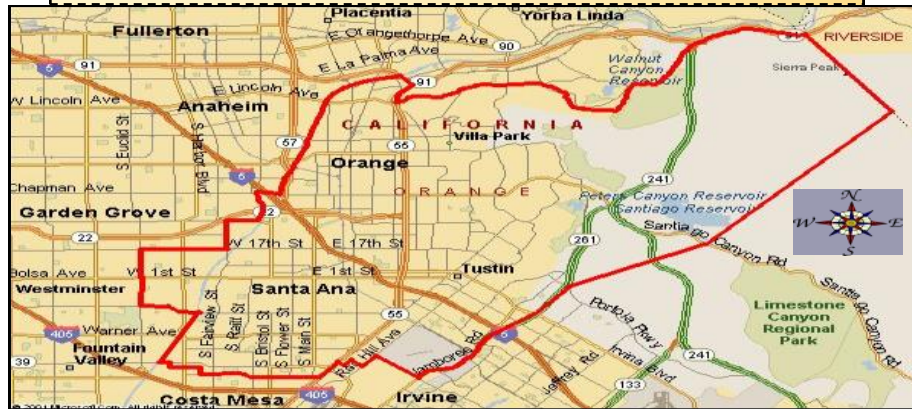

STEPS: 7, 8, & 9

"Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings."

[8]

"Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all."

[9]

"Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others."

STEP 7 (Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions Book - pg. 70):

(Para. 1): "SINCE this Step so specifically concerns itself with humility, we should pause here to consider what humility is and what the practice of it can mean to us."

(Para. 2): "Indeed, the attainment of greater humility is the foundation principle of each of A.A.'s Twelve Steps. For without some degree of humility, no alcoholic can stay sober at all..."

(Para. 3): "Humility, as a word and as an ideal, has a very bad time of it in our world. Not only is the idea misunderstood; the word itself is often intensely disliked..."

TRADITIONS: 7, 8, & 9

Short Form:

"Every A.A. group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions."

[8]

Short Form:

"Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever nonprofessional, but our service centers may employ special workers."

[9]

Short Form:

"A.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve."



TRADITION 9 (Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions Book - pg. 175):

(Para. 1) "Just as the aim of each A.A. member is personal sobriety, the aim of our services is to bring sobriety within reach of all who want it. If nobody does the group's chores, if the area's telephone rings unanswered, if we do not reply to our mail, then A.A. as we know it would stop. Our communications lines with those who need our help would be broken."

CONCEPTS: 7, 8, & 9

Short Form:

"The Charter and Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments, empowering the trustees to manage and conduct world service affairs. The Conference Charter is not a legal document; it relies upon tradition and the A.A. purse for final effectiveness."

[8]

Short Form:

"The trustees are the principal planners and administrators of over-all policy and finance. They have custodial oversight of the separately incorporated and constantly active services, exercising this through their ability to elect all the directors of these entities."

[9]

Short Form:

"Good service leadership at all levels is indispensable for our future functioning and safety. Primary world service leadership, once exercised by the founders, must necessarily be assumed by the trustees."

CONCEPTS 8 & 9—Trustee (Definition / The Little Big Book Dictionary):

"Member of a board elected or appointed to direct the funds and policy of an institution."
